CLARENCE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS:

Please call the Clarence Township Fire Department at (517) 857-3473 to obtain burning permits. Leave a message when prompted with your name, address, and the day/time you plan to burn. There is no fee to obtain a permit.

Only paper, trees, logs, brush, stumps, leaves, and grass clippings can be burnt.

Open burning of weeds, brush, and crop stubble on agricultural lands may be allowed if a permit is issued. Trash, plastics, tires, building construction/demolition waste, chemically treated lumber, plywood, synthetic/painted materials, electronics, or otherwise hazardous materials are not allowed to be burned. Fires may be extinguished and/or permits may be denied if materials deemed illegal/hazardous to burn are present, if weather conditions change, if fires are deemed unsafe and/or are unattended, or if the smoke begins to affect people in the area.

Call 911 for emergencies or burning complaints.
